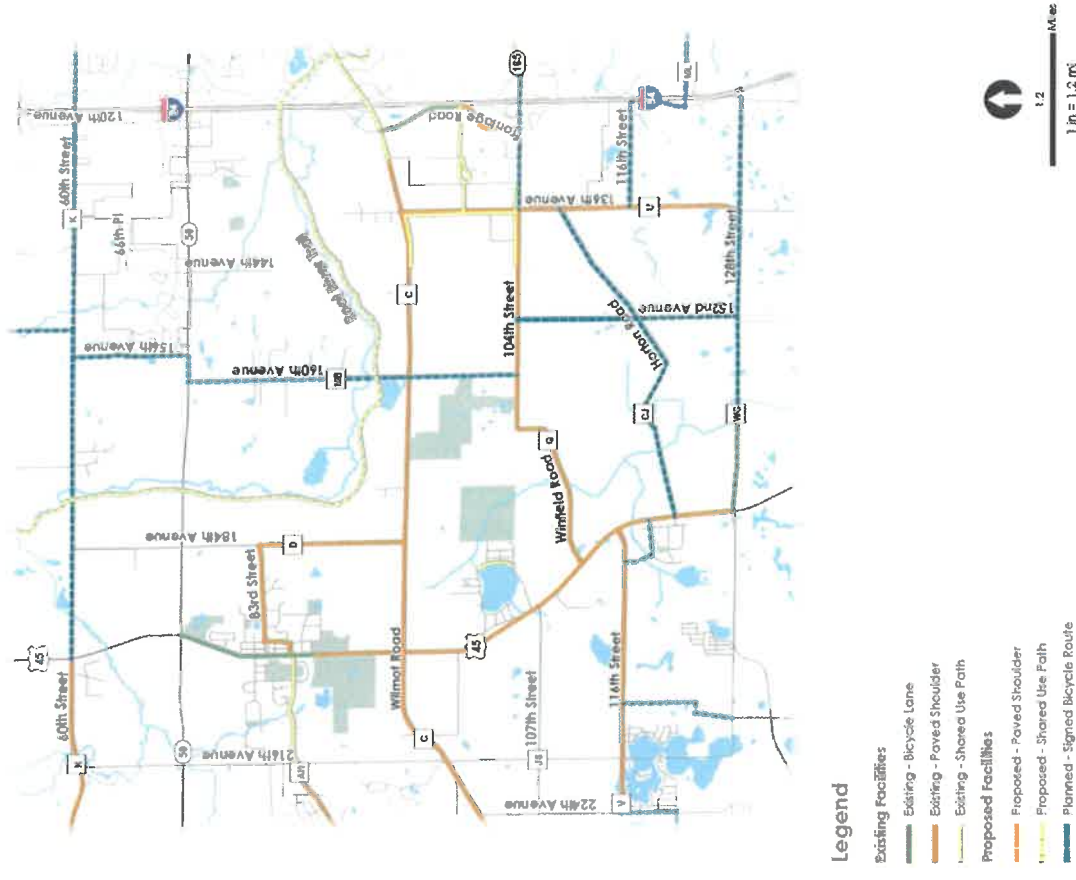

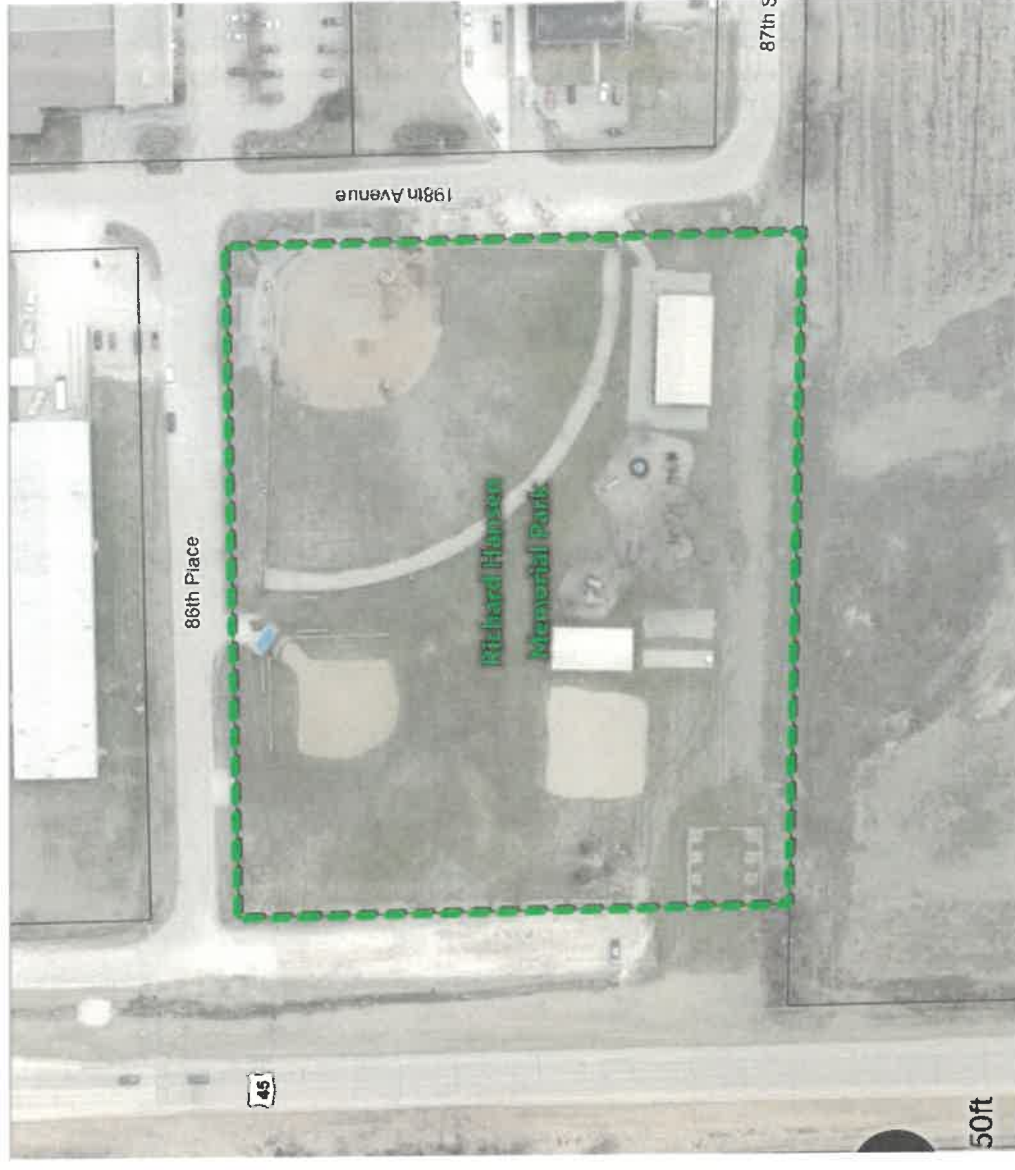

Richard Hansen Memorial Park

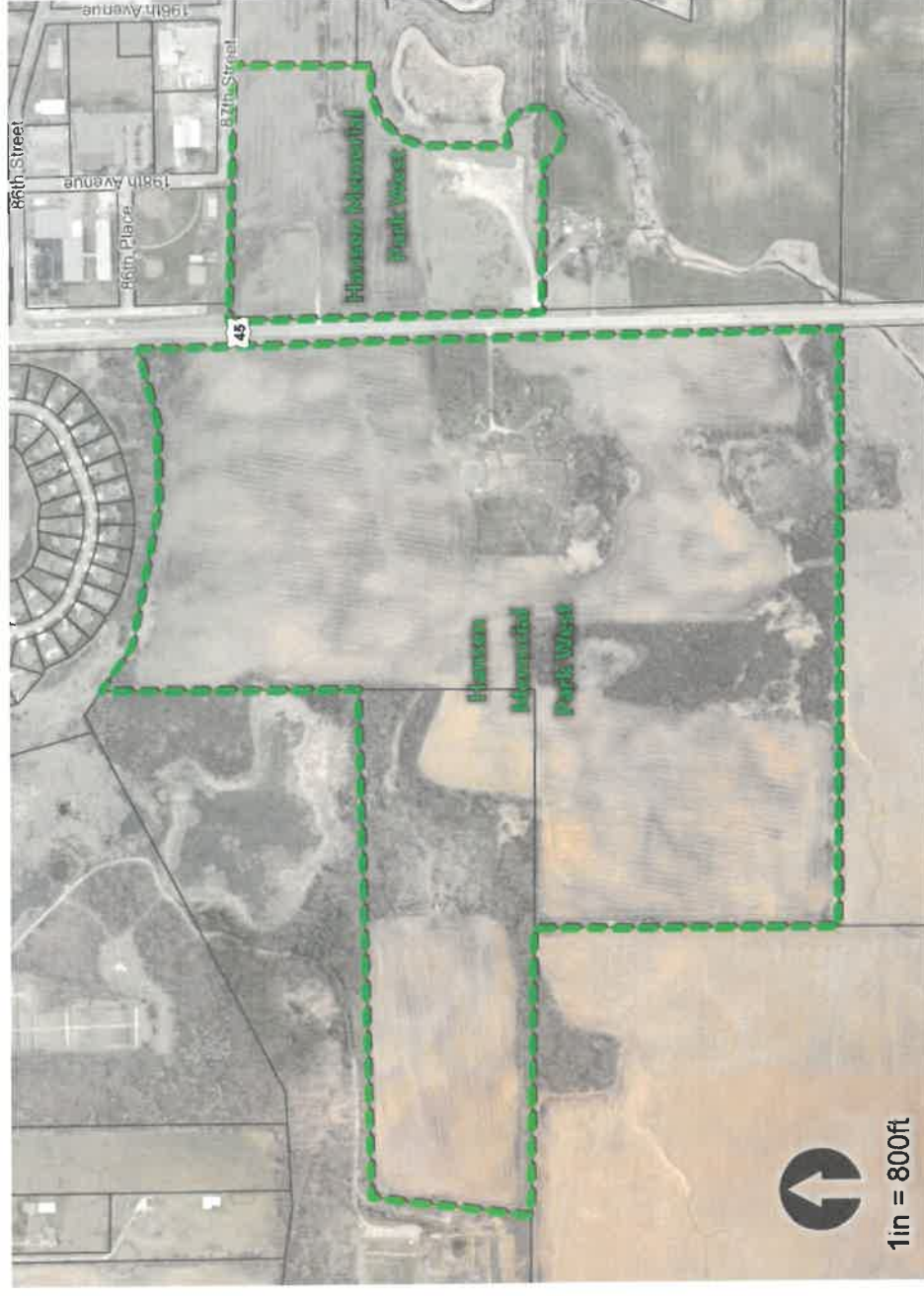
Existing Facilities:

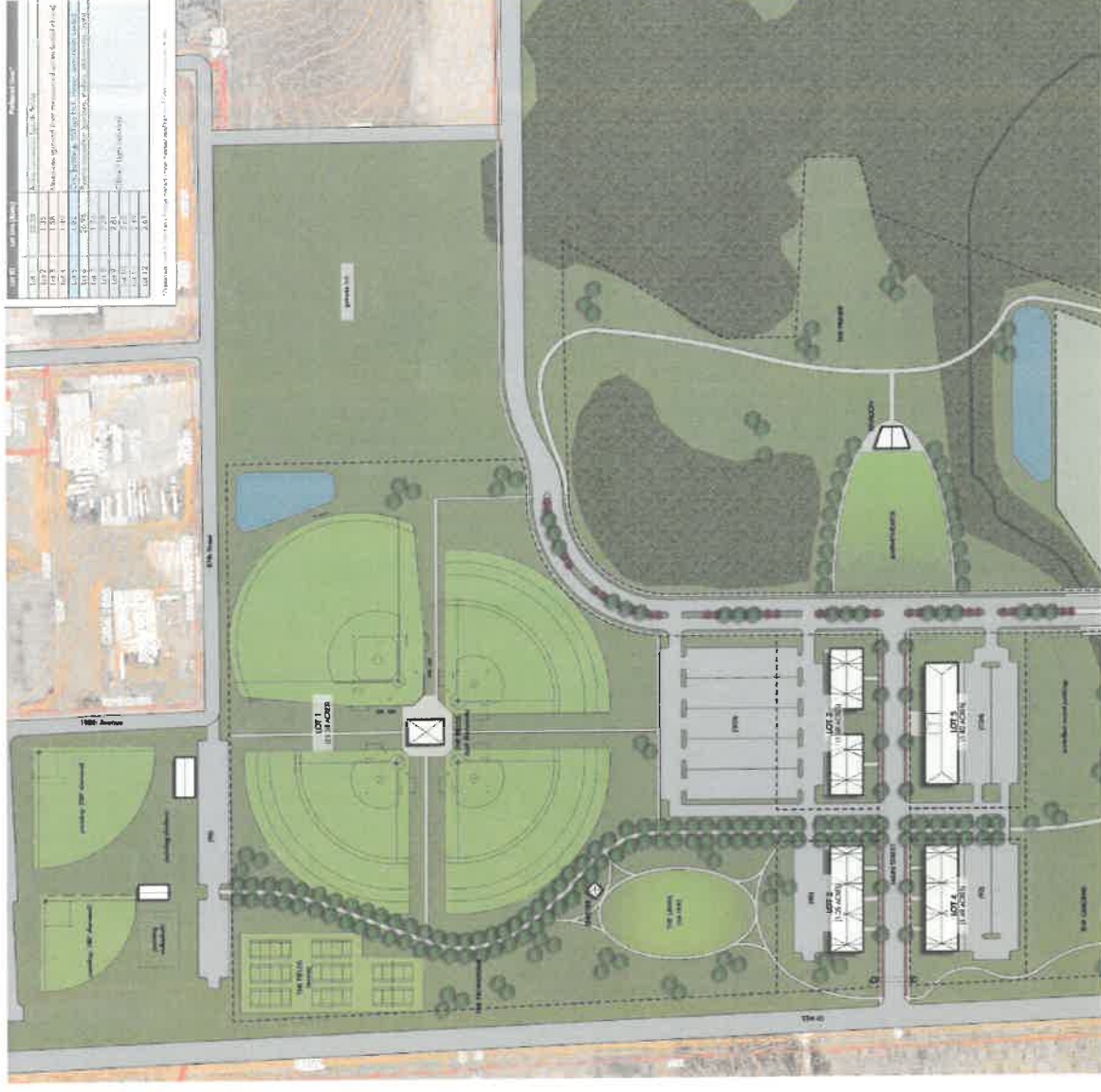


Hansen Memorial Park Expansion East

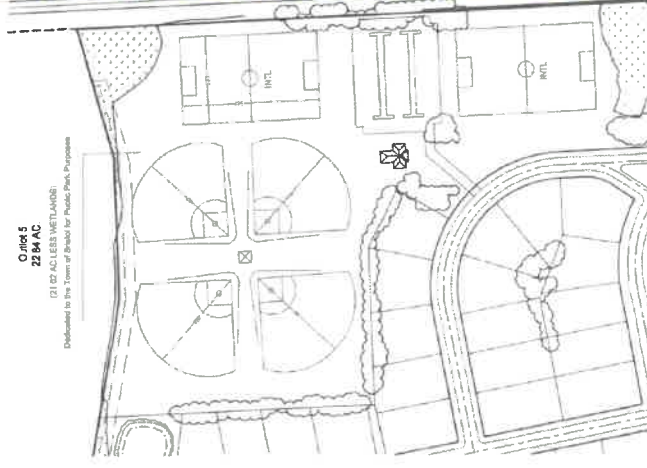
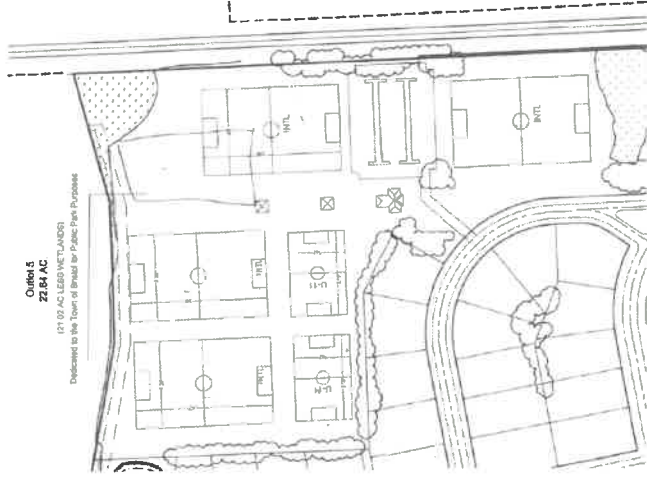
Bristol Estates Concept Site Plan

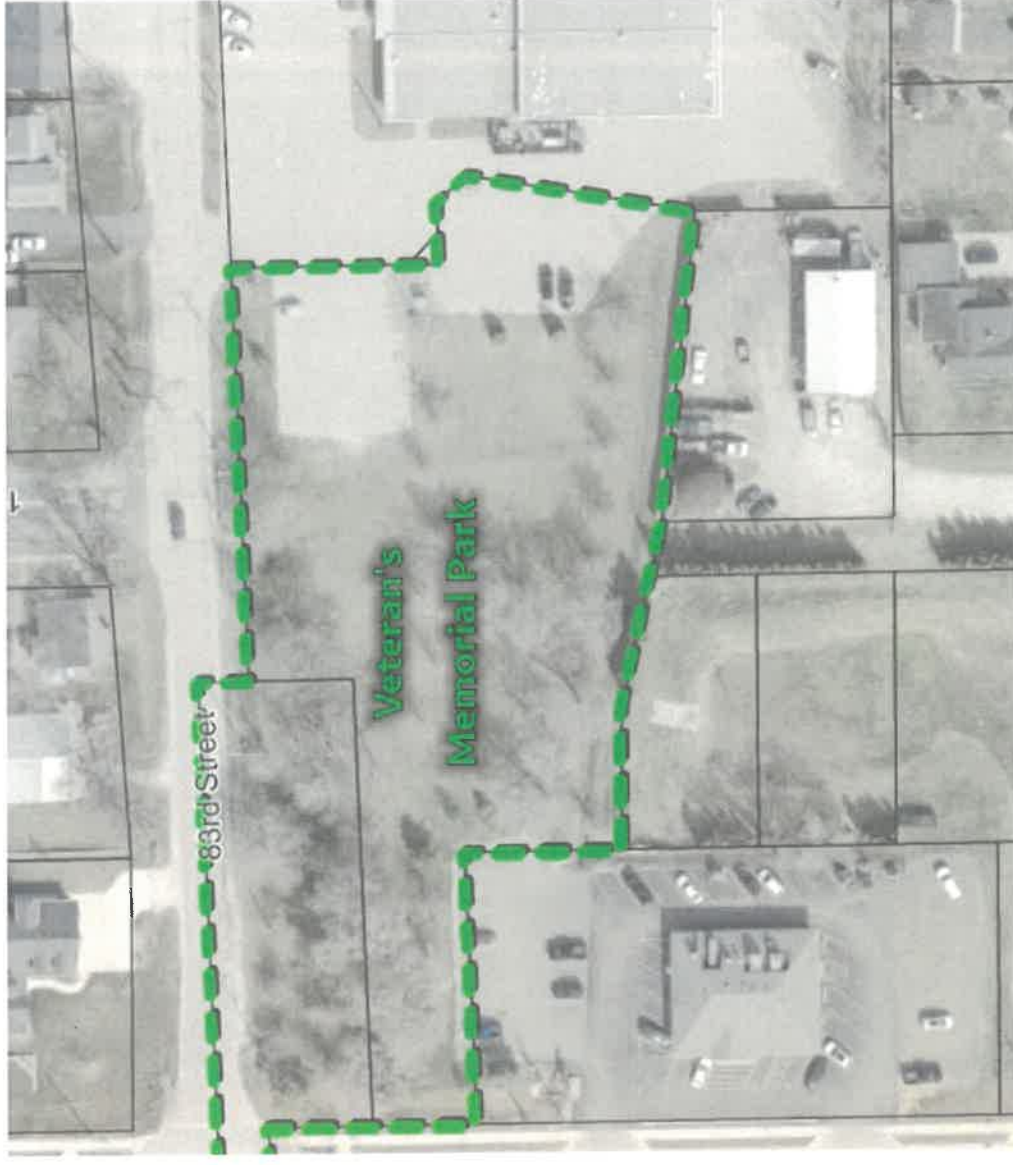

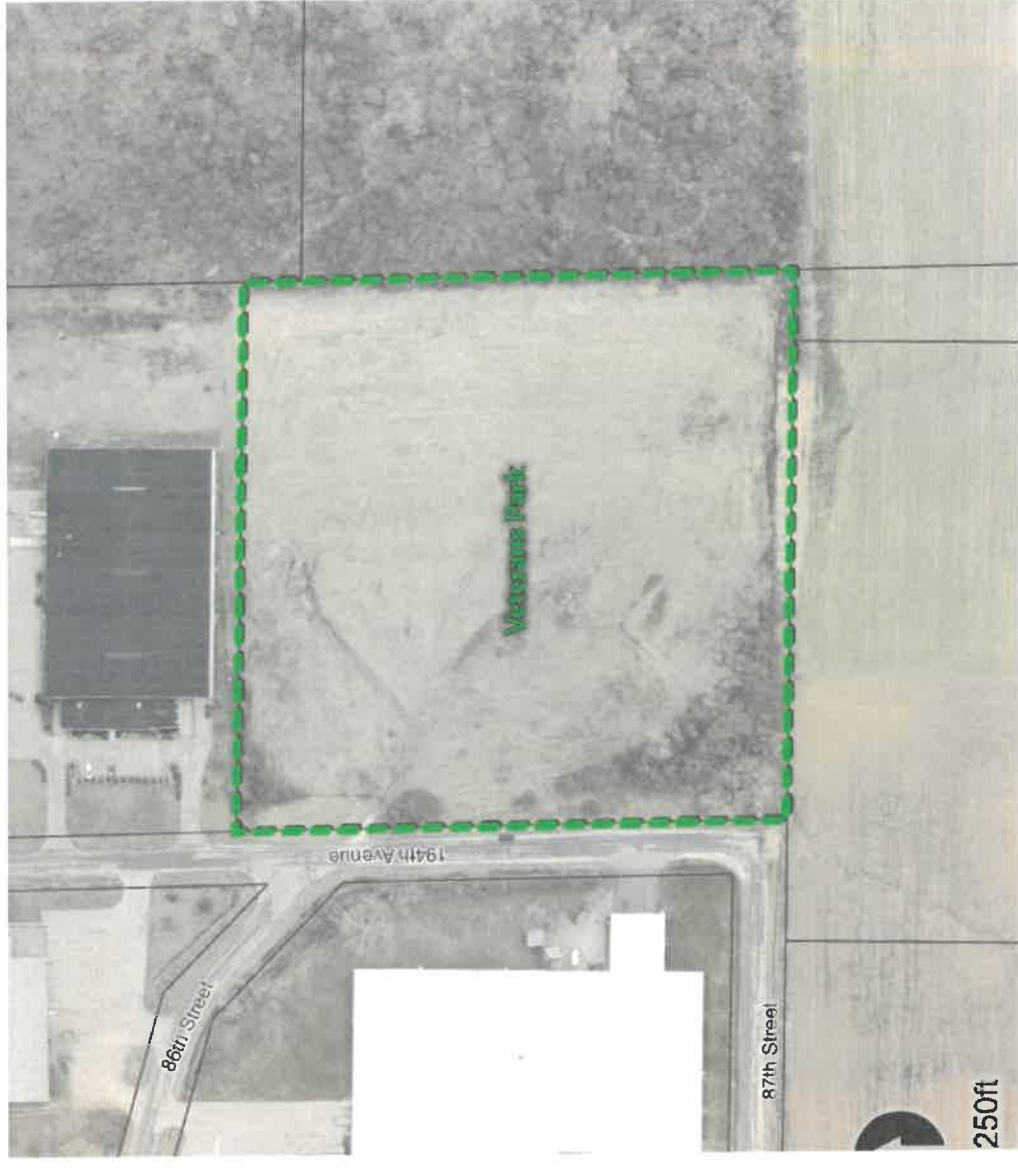
