

**ORDINANCE No. 2014-8**

**AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS FOR THE  
KEEPING OF CERTAIN FOWL ON RESIDENTIAL PARCELS**

The Village Board of the Village of Bristol, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

**SECTION I. AMENDMENT OF PROVISIONS.**

The conditional use listings of the following designated residential zoning districts of the Village of Bristol Code of Ordinances are amended by the addition of the following – R-1 Rural Residential District (parcels under five acres only); R-2 Suburban Single-Family Residential District; R-3 Urban Single-Family Residential District; R-4 Urban Single-Family Residential District; R-5 Urban Single-Family Residential District; R-6 Urban Single-Family Residential District; R-6A Urban Single-Family Residential District (Lake):

- ( ) As defined in Sec. 7-1-11(h)(1)c, the keeping of poultry species other than those specified in Sec. 7-1-11(b)(1).

**SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.**



**SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
