NURSERY SEEDLINGS – END OF THE YEAR

OFFERINGS

The Spring of 2016 came fast: Both the Wilson and Griffith Nurseries were lifting trees 1.5 weeks earlier than usual. This meant that we were able to get more seedlings processed and shipped earlier. Now, with weather conditions still conducive to planting, we are advertising our remaining seedlings to landowners, property managers and outdoor enthusiasts. The same restrictions on quantity and use still apply:

1. Minimum order of a packet (300 seedlings), 500 shrubs or 100 trees.
2. Not to be resold or used for decorative, ornamental, landscaping purposes or Christmas trees
3. Not to harvest or remove trees until they are large enough to be sold or utilized as cut merchantable forest products or a pre-commercial thinning. Or removed with roots attached for resale.
4. To protect the seedlings from fire or grazing.

If you are interested in purchasing any of the following species, please contact any of the three nurseries. Delivery is now limited to private carriers (at purchaser's expense) or nursery pick up.
