

**ORDINANCE No. 2015-4**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO  
STATUTORY REFERENCES**

The Village Board of the Village of Bristol, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

**SECTION I. AMENDMENT OF PROVISIONS.**

Section 1-1-2(l) of the Village of Bristol Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

- (n) **Wisconsin Statutes.** The term "Wisconsin Statutes" and its abbreviation as "Wis. Stats." shall mean, in this Code of Ordinances, the Wisconsin Statutes 2013-2014 edition, as amended from time to time; future amendments shall be incorporated herein.

**SECTION II. AMENDMENT OF PROVISIONS.**

Section 10-1-1(c) of the Village of Bristol Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

- (c) **Statutes Specifically Incorporated by Reference.** Whenever this Chapter incorporates by reference sections of the Wisconsin Statutes, such references shall mean the Wisconsin Statutes 2013-2014 edition as from time to time amended, repealed or modified by the Wisconsin Legislature.

**SECTION III. SEVERABILITY.**

If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

**SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
