

ORDINANCE No. 2016-1

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO MISCELLANEOUS SPEED RESTRICTIONS

The Village Board of the Village of Bristol, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. AMENDMENT OF PROVISIONS.

Section 10-1-12(d) of the Village of Bristol Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

(d) **Thirty-Five (35) Miles per Hour Limit.** No person shall operate any motor vehicle in excess of thirty-five (35) miles per hour on any Village of Bristol road, street or highway under the jurisdiction of the Village of Bristol as indicated by official speed limit signs as follows:

- (1) **83rd Street.** From 200th Avenue easterly to 184th Avenue.
- (2) **216th Avenue.** From State Hwy. 50 south to Cty. Hwy. AH.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.


This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
