

ORDINANCE No. 2016-5

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO STOP INTERSECTIONS**

The Village Board of the Village of Bristol, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

**SECTION I. AMENDMENT OF PROVISIONS.**

Section 10-1-13(a)(43) of the Village of Bristol Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

(43) **213th Avenue.**

- a. Vehicles traveling north on 213th Avenue shall stop before entering the intersection of 116th Street (Cty. Hwy. V).
- b. Vehicles traveling north and south on 213th Avenue shall stop before entering the intersection of 117th Street.
- c. Vehicles traveling north and south on 213th Avenue shall stop before entering the intersection of 214th Avenue.

**SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.**

If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

**SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
