You are invited to attend a public involvement meeting to learn more about the resurfacing and reconstruction of US 45 from the Illinois State Line to WIS 50 in the Village of Bristol, Kenosha County. A project location map is attached.

The purpose of this meeting is to present the final roadway design and to obtain input. Persons with a concern for or knowledge about historical or archaeological resources, drainage problems, or environmental issues such as hazardous wastes and underground storage tanks are encouraged to attend this meeting and provide information to the design consultant. Exhibits will be on display showing the proposed improvements. Engineers representing the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will be available to discuss the project and address any questions or concerns.

The purpose of this project is to improve the condition of the riding surface, improve turning movement capacity at intersections, widen intersections to accommodate bicycles, and improve sight distance and safety throughout the corridor. The proposed improvements will include adding curb & gutter and sidewalk from 86th Street to just south of WIS 50 and signal replacements at the WIS 50 intersections with County C and County WG. Roundabouts and shared use paths are not proposed for this project.

Construction is scheduled in 2018. US 45 will be closed to through traffic during construction. US 45 will be closed in two stages in order to reduce road closure time and to accommodate the Bristol Progress Days event. There will be a signed detour route. Access to adjacent businesses and properties will be maintained.

The project will be funded with state and federal funds. Right of way and temporary grading easements will be needed throughout the project.

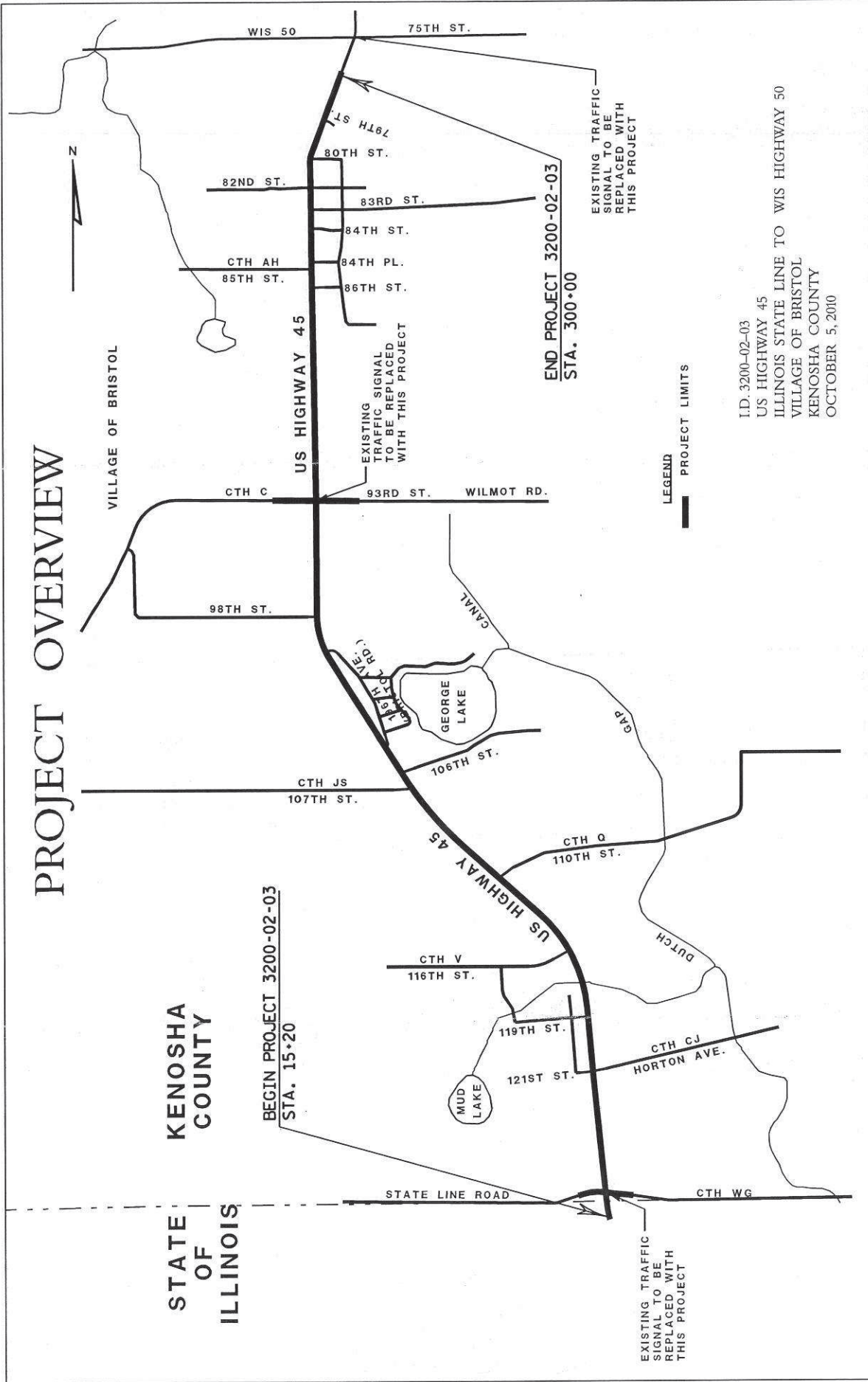
