The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) would like to invite you to a Public Involvement Meeting (PIM) for the resurfacing of US 45 from WIS 50 (Village of Bristol) to WIS 11 (Village of Union Grove) in Kenosha and Racine counties.

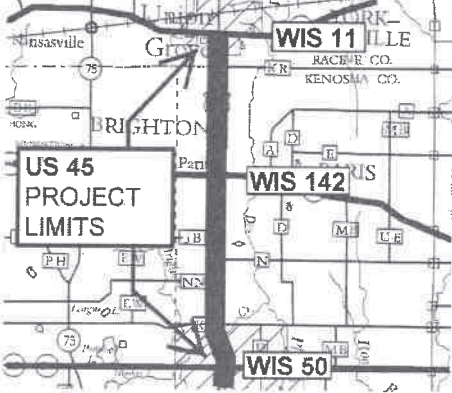
The format of the meeting will follow an informal, open house format. There will be no formal presentations for this meeting. WisDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and address any questions or concerns. Attendees may stop in at their convenience and view exhibits, meet with project staff, ask questions, and provide feedback.

WisDOT encourages property and business owners, interested residents, and other stakeholders to attend the meeting. The intent of the meeting is to re-introduce the project and to solicit feedback from the above parties.

Project Overview

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation is in the process of developing plans to improve US 45 from WIS 50 to WIS 11.

Project location map:



The project was initially scoped as a full reconstruction project with real estate acquisition including relocations throughout the length of the project. The concept was rescoped to a resurfacing in the fall of 2015.

Project Attributes:

- The existing pavement on US 45 has reached near the end of its life.
- The project will replace the existing asphalt pavement beginning in Bristol at the WIS 50 intersection and proceeding to 400 feet south of WIS 11 intersection.
- The proposed typical section will have the paved shoulders widened to five feet to accommodate bicyclists.
- Several aging box culverts will be replaced as part of the project.
- Right turn lanes and passing lanes will be added at County Road N (38th St.) and NN (45th St.) intersections to enhance traffic flow and safety.
- Traffic signals will be upgraded and the northbound right-turn lane will be expanded to improve safety at the WIS 50 intersection.
- Construction is tentatively scheduled for 2021.
