NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

**US 45
Resurfacing and Reconstruction
Illinois State Line to WIS 50
Kenosha County
Project I.D. 3200-02-03**

All interested persons are notified that the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will hold an open-house style information meeting to discuss the resurfacing and reconstruction of US 45 from the Illinois State Line to WIS 50 in the Village of Bristol, Kenosha County. A project location map is attached.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 5, 2010 at the Bristol Municipal Building, 19801 83rd Street, from 6 to 8 p.m. Engineers representing the Wisconsin Department of Transportation will be available to discuss the project and address any questions or concerns.

The purpose of this meeting is to introduce the project team, review preliminary roadway improvements, and to obtain input on the project. Persons with a concern for or knowledge about historical or archaeological resources, drainage problems, or environmental issues such as hazardous wastes and underground storage tanks are encouraged to attend this meeting and provide information to the design team. Exhibits will be on display showing the proposed improvements.

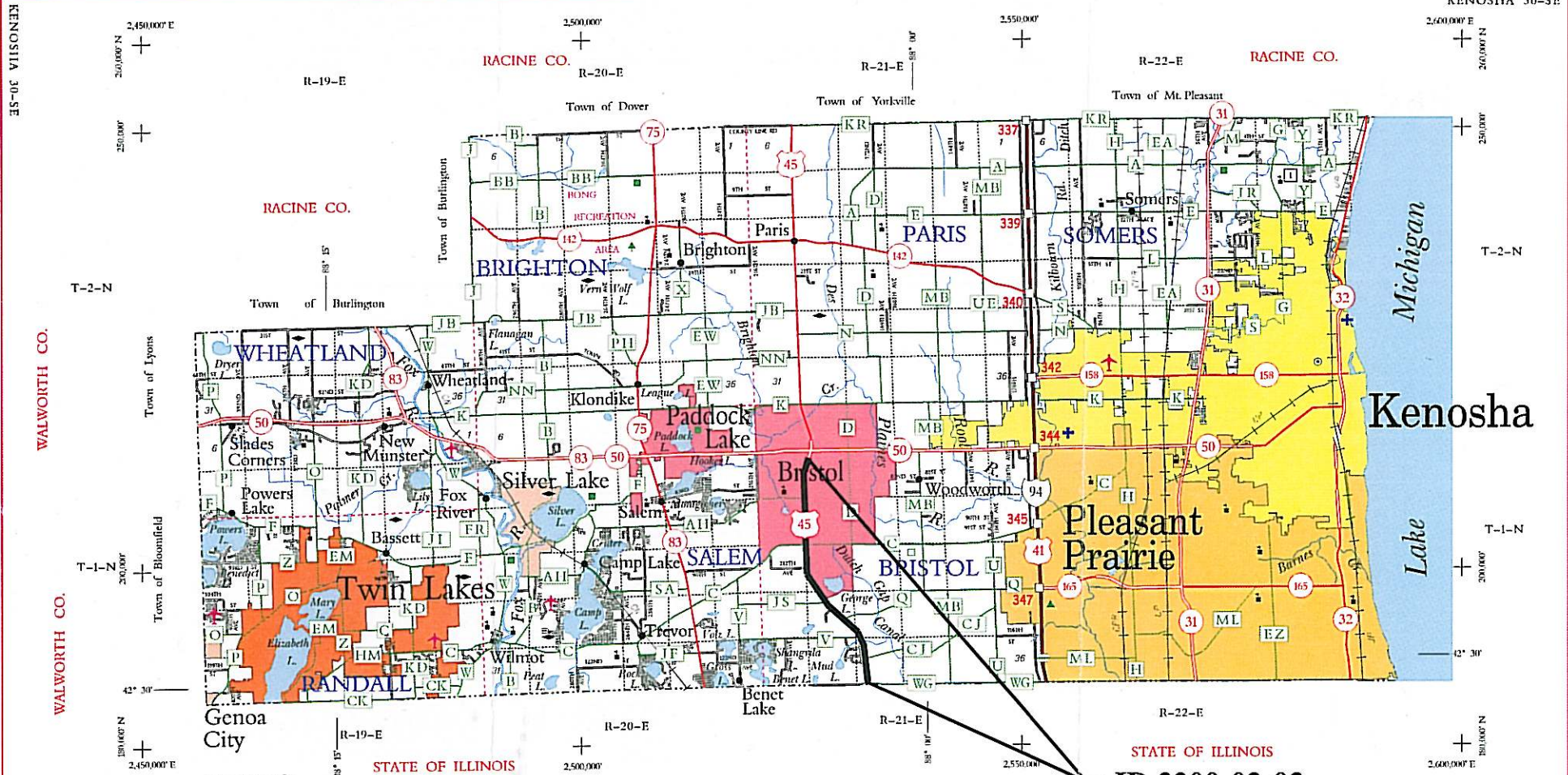
The purpose of this project is to improve the condition of the riding, improve turning movement capacity at intersections, widen intersections to accommodate bicycles, and improve sight distance and safety throughout the corridor.

Construction is tentatively scheduled in 2012. US 45 will be closed to through traffic during construction. There will be a signed detour route. Access to adjacent businesses and properties will be maintained.

The project will be funded with state and federal funds. Adjacent property owners will not be assessed for the road construction costs. Right of way and temporary grading easements will be needed for the resurfacing and reconstruction segments and areas of minor intersection improvements

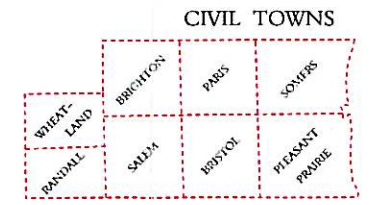


MILES OF HIGHWAY as of Dec. 31, 2008
