The Bristol Wisconsin Historical Society Inc. received permission from the Bristol Village Board on 10/12/15 to relocate the old 1870 historic town hall to the Fireman's Park located east of the Bristol fire station. Many interested people showed up to the Bristol Village Board meeting to show support for the Historical Society and for relocating the old town hall.

The society will restore the old town hall once it is relocated. It is the first town hall in Bristol and was used as a gathering place. The Bristol Wi. Historical Society will benefit the community and preserve our history for future generations. The hall will be used as a museum for educational purposes by schools, scouting organizations, and other community organizations, programs, and citizens that benefit from the learning experience of an original 1870's town hall. It will get people involved thru historic demonstrations like mock town hall meetings and restoring old artifacts. School children and their parents will learn about the area thru visiting the hall. It can be used for other events like reunions, weddings, plays, holiday programs, 4H, HCE, scouts, and adds an historic meeting hall to the community.
