

**ORDINANCE NO. 2017-4**

**AN ORDINANCE REGARDING  
FRAUD ON COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS**

The Village Board of the Village of Bristol, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

**SECTION I. ADOPTION OF PROVISIONS; RENUMBERING OF PROVISIONS.**

Sections 11-3-12 and 11-3-13 of the Village of Bristol Code of Ordinances pertaining are renumbered to Sections 11-3-13 and 11-3-14 respectively, and Section 11-3-12 is adopted to read as follows:

**Sec. 11-3-12 Fraud on Commercial Establishments.**

- (a) **Definition.** In this Section, "recreational attraction" means a public accommodation designed for amusement and includes chair lifts or ski resorts, water parks, theaters, entertainment venues, racetracks, swimming pools, trails, golf courses, carnivals and amusement parks.
- (b) **Fraud Prohibited.** Whoever does any of the following may be penalized as provided in this Section:
  - (1) Obtained any food, beverage, lodging, ticket or other means of admission, or other service or accommodation at any campground, hotel, motel, boarding or lodging house, restaurant, or recreational facility, and intentionally absconds without paying for such goods, services and/or admission.
  - (2) Intentionally defrauded the keeper of any campground, hotel, motel, boarding or lodging house, or restaurant in any transaction arising out of the relationship as a guest.
  - (3) Engaged in intentional fraudulent behavior or activity intended to deprive the owner of a commercial establishment of just compensation for goods and/or services received.
  - (4) Obtained any transportation service from a taxicab operator or similar transportation provider and intentionally absconds without paying for the service.
  - (5) Obtained gasoline, diesel or other fuel from a service station, garage, or other place where such fuel is sold at retail, and intentionally absconds without paying for the fuel.

**SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.**

If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

**SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.


