

ORDINANCE No. 2018-12

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING ELECTRONIC RECORDS PRESERVATION

The Village Board of the Village of Bristol, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. ADOPTION OF PROVISIONS.

Section 3-3-10 of the Village of Bristol Code of Ordinances is created to read as follows:

Sec. 3-3-10 Electronic Records Preservation.

The custodian of records may keep and preserve public records by means of microfilm or other reproductive device, optical imaging or electronic formatting. Such records shall meet the standards for reproduction set forth in Secs. 16.61(7) and 16.612, Wis. Stats., and ADM 12.01 through 12.05, Wis. Adm. Code, and shall be considered original records for all purposes.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.


This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.


