

**ORDINANCE No. 2019-10**

**AN ORDINANCE REGARDING GAMBLING IN LICENSED ESTABLISHMENTS**

The Village Board of the Village of Bristol, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

**SECTION I. AMENDMENT OF PROVISIONS.**

Section 7-2-14 of the Village of Bristol Code of Ordinances is amended by the addition of a new Subsection (I), to read as follows:

(I) **Gambling Regulations; Video Gambling Machines.** For purposes of this Section, "gambling machine" shall be as defined in Sec. 945.01, Wis. Stats. Except as authorized by state law, no gambling or game of chance of any type shall be permitted in any form upon any premises licensed under this Chapter or the laws of the State of Wisconsin. The premises for which a Class "B" or "Class B" license has been issued may have not more than five (5) video gambling machines on the licensed premises for entertainment purposes. The regulation and penalties of gambling machines shall be as prescribed in Secs. 945.02 – 945.041, Wis. Stats.

**SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.**

If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

**SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
