

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-7

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A CONSOLIDATED POLLING PLACE

The Village Board of the Village of Bristol, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. REPEAL AND ADOPTION OF PROVISIONS.

Section 2-1-4 of the *Village of Bristol Code of Ordinances* is repealed and re-adopted to read as follows:

Sec. 2-1-4 Polling Place.

The polling place serving all wards in the Village of Bristol (Wards 1-7) shall be the Village of Bristol Municipal Building located at 19801 83rd Street in the Village of Bristol, Kenosha County, Wisconsin.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
